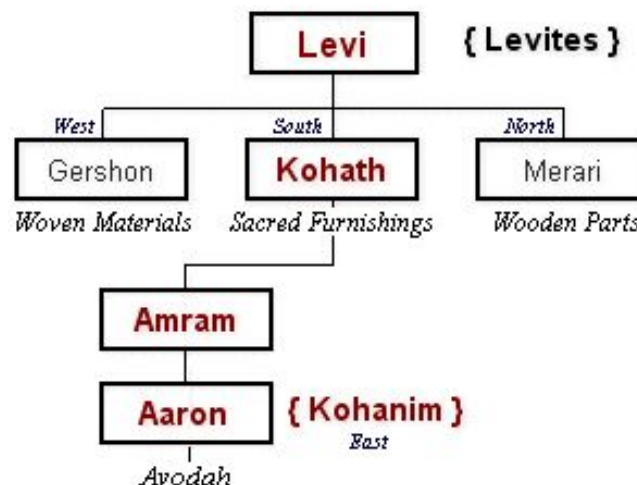

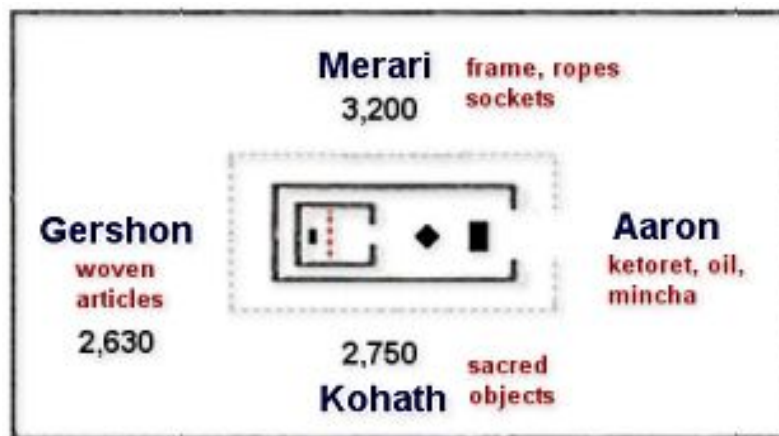
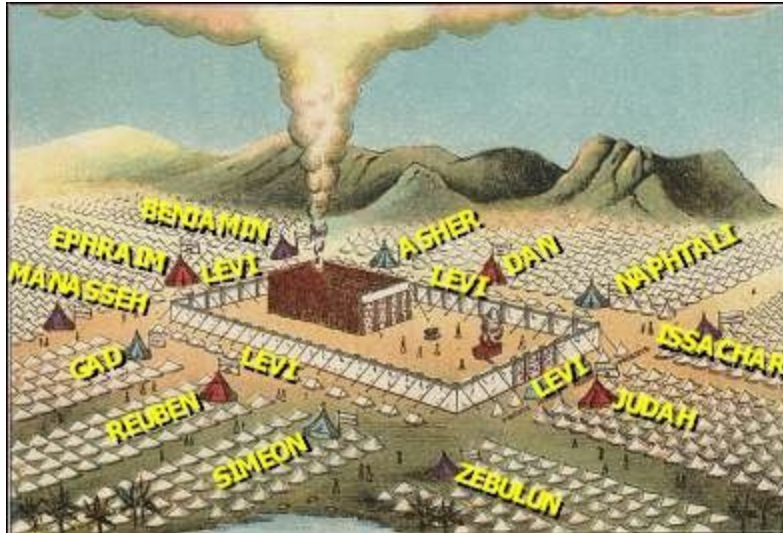
Torah: Numbers 4:21-7:89

Prophets: Judges 13:2-5

Gospel: Luke 1:11-20

- **Numbers 4:21-23 (NASB)** ²¹Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²²"Take a census of the sons of Gershon also, by their fathers' households, by their families; ²³from thirty years and upward to fifty years old, you shall number them; all who enter to perform the service to do the work in the tent of meeting.
- **Psalm 121:1-2 (NASB)** ¹I will lift up my eyes to the mountains; From where shall my help come? ²My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth.
- **Exodus 12:37-38 (KJV)** And the children of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand on foot *that were* men, beside children. ³⁸ And a mixed multitude went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, *even* very much cattle.





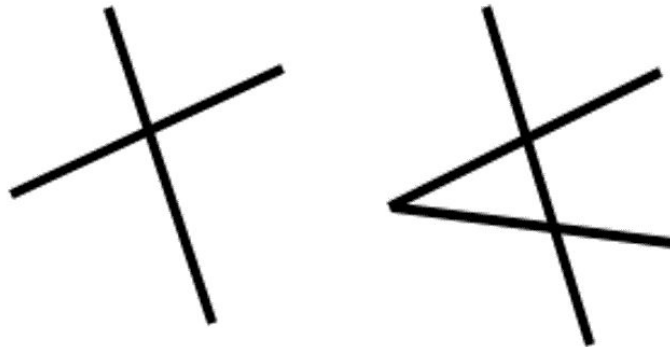
- **Numbers 5:15 (NASB)** ¹⁵ the man shall then bring his wife to the priest...
- **Matthew 26:57 (NASB)** ⁵⁷ Those who had seized Jesus led Him away to Caiaphas, the high priest,
- **Numbers 5:18 (NASB)** ¹⁸ ...and in the hand of the priest is to be the water of bitterness that brings a curse.
- **Matthew 26:39 (NASB)** ³⁹ And He went a little beyond *them*, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."
- **Galatians 3:13 (NASB)** Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"—

- **Numbers 5:20 (NASB)** ²⁰ if you, however, have gone astray...
- **1 Peter 2:25 (NASB)** ²⁵ For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.
- **Numbers 5:23-24 (NASB)** "The priest shall then write these curses on a scroll, and he shall wash them off into the water of bitterness. ²⁴"Then he shall make the woman drink the water of bitterness that brings a curse, so that the water which brings a curse will go into her and *cause bitterness*.
- **Colossians 2:13-14 (NASB)** When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, ¹⁴ having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.
- **Isaiah 53:6 (KJV)** All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- **Hosea 2:23 (NASB)** "I will sow her for Myself in the land. I will also have compassion on her who had not obtained compassion, And I will say to those who were not My people, 'You are My people!' And they will say, '*You are my God!*'"
- **Romans 9:25-26 (NASB)** ²⁵ As He says also in Hosea, "I WILL CALL THOSE WHO WERE NOT MY PEOPLE, 'MY PEOPLE,' AND HER WHO WAS NOT BELOVED, 'BELOVED.'" ²⁶ "AND IT SHALL BE THAT IN THE PLACE WHERE IT WAS SAID TO THEM, 'YOU ARE NOT MY PEOPLE,' THERE THEY SHALL BE CALLED SONS OF THE LIVING GOD."
- **Genesis 48:14-16 (NASB)** ¹⁴ But Israel stretched out his right hand and laid it on the head of Ephraim, who was the younger, and his left hand on Manasseh's head, **crossing his hands**, although Manasseh was the firstborn. ¹⁵ He blessed Joseph, and said, "The God before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, The God who has been my shepherd all my life to this day, ¹⁶ **The angel who has redeemed me from all evil**, Bless the lads; And may my name live on in them, And the names of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And may they grow into a **multitude** in the midst of the earth."

- **Isaiah 53:4-6 (NASB)** ⁴ Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted. ⁵ But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed. ⁶ All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.

The Priestly Blessing

Numbers 6:22-27 (NASB) ²²Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²³"Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'Thus you shall bless the sons of Israel.
