


Yom Teruah

Psalms 47:6 (TLV)


6 God is gone up amidst shouting, Adonai amidst the sound of the shofar.

Daniel 12 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

1 "At that time Michael, the great prince who stands
guard over the sons of your people, will arise. There
will be a time of distress such as has never occurred
since the beginning of the nation until then. But at that
time your people—everyone who is found written in
the book—will be delivered.

Day of the Awakening Blast

Daniel 12 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

2 Multitudes who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake—some to everlasting life, and others to shame and everlasting contempt. 3 Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavenly expanse. And those who turn many to righteousness will be like the stars forever and ever.

Day of the Awakening Blast

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 (TLV)

16 For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the blast of God's shofar, and the dead in Messiah shall rise first. 17 Then we who are alive, who are left behind, will be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air—and so we shall always be with the Lord.

Unleavened Bread (Nisan 15) - FULL MOON

Sukkot (Tishri 15) - FULL MOON

Yom Teruah (Tishri 1) - NEW MOON

1 Corinthians 15:51-53 (TLV)

51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep,
but we shall all be changed—

52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye,
at the last shofar. For the shofar will sound,
and the dead will be raised incorruptible,
and we will be changed.

53 For this corruptible must put on incorruptibility,
and this mortal must put on immortality.

The Last Trump

On Yom Teruah, the shofar is blown 100 times.
There are four (4) types of shofar blasts:

1. *Tekiah*- one long, straight blast
2. *Shevarim*- 3 short blasts
3. *Teruah*- 9 short, rapid, staccato blasts
4. *Tekia Gedolah (Last trump)*- longest of the blasts, played
