Leviticus 23:27 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

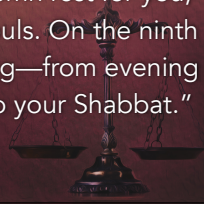
27 "However, the tenth day of this seventh month is Yom Kippur, a holy convocation to you, so you are to afflict yourselves. You are to bring an offering made by fire to Adonai.

Acts 27:9 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

9 Since considerable time had passed and the voyage was already dangerous because **the Fast** had already gone by, Paul kept warning them,

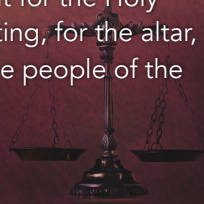
Leviticus 23:32 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

32 It is to be a Shabbat of solemn rest for you, and you are to humble your souls. On the ninth day of the month in the evening—from evening until evening—you are to keep your Shabbat.”



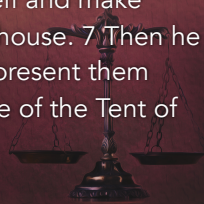
Leviticus 16:33 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

33 He is to make atonement for the Holy Sanctuary, for the Tent of Meeting, for the altar, for the kohanim, and for all the people of the assembly.



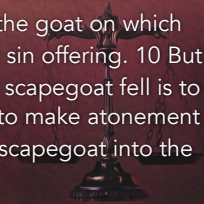
Leviticus 16:6-10 Tree of Life Version

6 Then Aaron is to offer the bull for the sin offering which is for himself and make atonement for himself and his house. 7 Then he is take the two goats and present them before Adonai at the entrance of the Tent of Meeting.



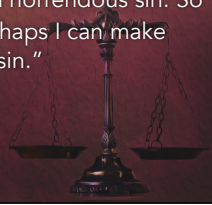
Leviticus 16:6-10 Tree of Life Version

8 Aaron will then cast lots for the two goats—one lot for Adonai, and the other lot for the scapegoat. 9 Aaron is to present the goat on which the lot for Adonai fell and make it a sin offering. 10 But the goat upon which the lot for the scapegoat fell is to be presented alive before Adonai, to make atonement upon it, by sending it away as the scapegoat into the wilderness.



Exodus 32:30-33 Tree of Life Version

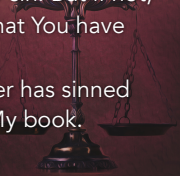
30 So it happened the following day, Moses said to the people, "You have committed a horrendous sin. So now I will go up to Adonai—perhaps I can make atonement for your sin."

31 Then Moses returned to Adonai and said, "Alas, these people have sinned greatly, and made gods of gold! 32 Yet now, please forgive their sin. But if not, please blot me out of Your book that You have written."

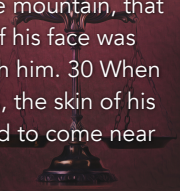
33 Adonai said to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot out of My book."



Exodus 34:29-30 Tree of Life Version

29 Now it happened, when Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hand when he came down from the mountain, that

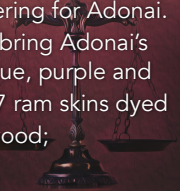
Moses did not know that the skin of his face was radiant, because God had spoken with him. 30 When Aaron and all Bnei-Yisrael saw Moses, the skin of his face shone in rays, so they were afraid to come near him.



Exodus 35:4-7 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

4 Moses also said to all the congregation of Bnei-Yisrael, "This is the word which Adonai commanded saying: 5 Take from among you an offering for Adonai.

Whoever has a willing heart, let him bring Adonai's offering: gold, silver and bronze; 6 blue, purple and scarlet cloth; fine linen and goat hair; 7 ram skins dyed red, sealskins and acacia wood;



Leviticus 23:39-40 Tree of Life Version

39 "So on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruits of the land, you are to keep the Feast of Adonai for seven days. The first day is to be a Shabbat rest, and the eighth day will also be a Shabbat rest. 40 On the first day you are to take choice fruit of trees, branches of palm trees, boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook, and rejoice before Adonai your God for seven days.

כָּפַר kâphar, kaw-far'

- to cover (specifically with bitumen)
- figuratively, to expiate or condone
- to placate or cancel:—appease
- make (an atonement, cleanse, disannul, forgive, be merciful, pacify, pardon, purge (away), put off, (make) reconcile(-liation)).

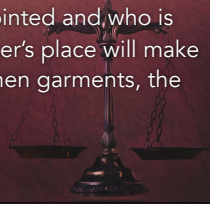
16 Then Adonai spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they approached the presence of Adonai and died. 2 Adonai said to Moses, "Tell Aaron your brother not to come at just any time into the Holiest Place behind the curtain—before the atonement cover which is on the Ark—so that he would not die. For I will be appearing in the cloud over the atonement cover.

Leviticus 16 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

29 "It is to be a statute to you forever, that in the seventh month, on the tenth day of the month, you are to afflict your souls, and do no kind of work—both the native-born and the outsider dwelling among you. 30 For on this day atonement will be made for you, to cleanse you. From all your sins you will be clean before Adonai.

Leviticus 16 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

31 It is a Shabbat of solemn rest to you, and you are to afflict your souls. It is a statute forever. 32 The kohen who is anointed and who is consecrated to be kohen in his father's place will make the atonement, and put on the linen garments, the holy garments.



Leviticus 16 Tree of Life Version (TLV)

33 He is to make atonement for the Holy Sanctuary, for the Tent of Meeting, for the altar, for the kohanim, and for all the people of the assembly. 34 "This will be an everlasting statute for you, to make atonement for Bnei-Yisrael once in the year because of all their sins." It was done as Adonai commanded Moses.
